WESLEY V. BAUGHMAN.

Wesley V. Baughman, 63 years old, for more than 37 years a conductor on the Pennsylvania Railroad, died Tuesday night, after a long illness, at the home of his brother-in-law, Thomas G. Bloom, postmaster at Mount Washington. Mr. Baughman, who was a widower, had been retired for five years. He was a brother of Charles L. Baughman, train dispatcher of the Pennsylvania railroad at Union Station. Also surviving are another brother, William Emory Baughman, and three sisters, Mrs. Ella Rotke, Mrs. Laura Just, of Syracuse, N. Y., and Mrs. Jennie Robertson, of Albany, N. Y.

The funeral will take place at 3 o'clock this afternoon from his residence, and will be conducted by the Waverly Lodge of Masons. The Rev. Charles O. Isaac, pastor of Mount Washington Methodist Episcopal Church, will read the burial service. Representatives of the Brotherhood of Railway Conductors will attend. Burial will be in Druid Ridge Cemetery.

MRS. HETTY C. BROWNLEY.

Mrs. Hetty C. Brownley, mother of Otis C. Brownley, chief bookkeeper in the office of Daniel V. Loden, Collector of Water Rents and Licenses, died yesterday afternoon at her home, 1218 East Preston street, from the infirmities of age.

Mrs. Brownley was 88 years old, and had been in failing health since June. She was a native of Massachusetts, but came here when a young woman, and married Joseph Brownley, of this city.

Besides Mrs. Brownley's son, a daughter, Mrs. John O'Connor, survives. Funeral services will be held at 4 o'clock Friday afternoon, from her home, the Rev. W. H. Carson, pastor of Grace Baptist Church, officiating, and burial will be in Greenmount Cemetery.
